

Supporting Documents Required for Claiming Statutory Benefits

These are the supporting documents that will be required when claiming statutory benefits. Ensure that you keep them safely so that you are able to find them easily. Take these documents along with you when attending a benefit interview or when claiming benefits so that the required documents are there when you need it.

- Valid Nepali passport
- Service record (Lal) book, AFB108
- Any other official benefits paper (e.g. DWP Pension Credit (PC) notification letter)
- Utility bill statement (gas/water/electric)
- UK bank statement if you already have an account (not more than 3 months old)
- Service pension certificate
- Nepal bank account statements (if you have bank account in Nepal)
- National Insurance Card/number
- If in work, five company payslips
- NHS medical card or NHS letter
- Tenancy agreement document
- TB screening medical certificate from Nepal (for proof of DOB)
